

Charles Tribble Conservation Scholarship

Sponsored by the
Harrison County Soil & Water Conservation District

This scholarship is open to any high school graduate who is a resident of Harrison County and who will enroll in a minimum of six class hours at a two or four year accredited institution in a conservation, environmental, and/or science program of studies. Verification of enrollment will be required. Previous scholarship recipients are allowed to apply again, but priority will be given to qualified applicants who have not received this scholarship before.

This is a \$1,000 scholarship. Half of the scholarship will be awarded for the fall term. Upon successful completion of the fall term with a minimum 2.5 GPA and enrollment in Spring semester (at least 6 credit hours) proven by submission of college transcript, the remaining half will be awarded for the spring term.

Application must be typed. Official copy of your most current high school/college transcript must accompany this application along with a letter of recommendation.

Completed applications should be returned to the Harrison County Soil & Water Conservation District Office on or before April 5, 2019 at 4:30 pm.

Scholarship recipient will be recognized at the high school awards program and the Soil Conservation Annual Meeting, invitations will be mailed.
