Applicants must be enrolling in a minimum of six credit hours at a two- or four-year accredited institution in a conservation, environmental, or science program of study supporting our mission of soil stewardship and agriculture; in the 2024-2025 School Year. Verification of enrollment will be required. Previous scholarship recipients are allowed to apply again, but priority will be given to qualified applicants who have not received this scholarship before.

This is a \$1,000 scholarship. Half of the scholarship will be awarded to you for the Fall term at the Harrison County Conservation District Annual Meeting (date TBA). Upon successful completion of the Fall term with a minimum 2.5 GPA and enrollment in the Spring semester (at least 6 credit hours) proven by submission of college transcript, the remaining half of the scholarship will be awarded.

Application <u>must</u> be typed. <u>Official copy of your most current high school/college transcript must accompany</u> this application along with a letter of recommendation.

It will also be available at the Harrison County High School (counselor's office).
