Gateway and Barn Access Erosion Program

The purpose of this program is to help Harrison County Landowners with the necessary means to maintain their gateways/barn entrances to reduce degradation, soil erosion and pollution.

<p><u>Eligibility:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -50/50 cost share rate not to exceed \$500.00 (Reimbursement 50% of expenses, up to \$500.00) -One household per FSA farm number, landowner, and/or household -Must have Ag Water Quality Plan -Only gateways and barn access points, does NOT cover driveways 	<p><u>Requirements:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Application must be approved BEFORE starting project -Project must be completed <u>within 90 days after approval</u> -Must use non-woven filter fabric -Submit Before & After pictures of your project, and sign print release allowing us to use pictures of your project for social media, marketing and other advertising needs. -Must install at least 6 inches of stone to secure fabric -Ensure full coverage of filter fabric by the rock -Notify district when project is completed for a checkout -Submit receipts for a payment request -Maintenance must be provided after 10 years
