Cephalanthus occidentalis

Tolerances: Alkaline soil
Occ. flooding, Wet Sites

Buttonbush is a great shrub for naturalizing in wet areas and attracts numerous species of butterflies, and more than 24 species of birds. It has glossy green leaves and fragrant, round flower clusters during mid-summer.
